## Plans for September

For all parents and carers  
From: Wed 3 September 2020

All classes and all children are expected to return to school from Wednesday 3 September. A new risk assessment is currently in process and will be reviewed and regularly updated to mitigate risks of the transmission of the virus.

The following will be in place:

- Regular handwashing for all
- Frequent cleaning of surfaces
- Anyone showing symptoms will be immediately isolated and asked to take a test
- Groups of pupils will be whole classes
- Classes of pupils will not mix
- Break times and lunchtimes will be staggered so that groups do not mix
- All available entrances to school will be utilised to reduce mixing between families
- No large gatherings will take place such as assemblies in the hall
- Limiting visitors to school
- Only one family member to pick up / drop off
- Equipment regularly cleaned in younger years
- Personal equipment for older years
- Rooms will be ventilated, and doors propped open
- No singing will take place
- PE will be non-contact
- No extra-curricular clubs for autumn term 1
- One-way system in playground for parents

Further information will be sent around these plans at the end of term.
