

Young Oxford Art Competition

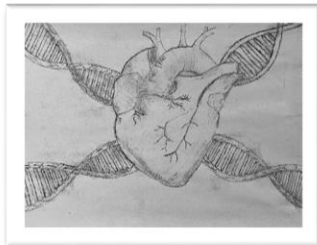

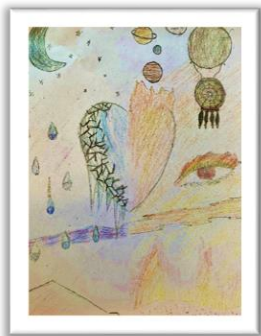
