The understanding that everyone is capable of success, but this takes many years of deliberate and focused practice.
Creativity	I use my imagination to come up with fresh ideas or brand-new products or solutions.	The ability to generate ideas and/or to conceive something entirely new
Connection Finding	I use my experiences to build on my learning.	The ability to use connections from past experiences to seek possible generalisations.
Problem solving	I can break a complex problem down step by step.	The ability to break down a complex task independently, decide on a suitable approach, and then act
Critical thinking	I can use evidence to explain what I think and why.	The ability to analyse evidence, assess its validity and relevance, and use this evaluation to form well-reasoned judgements and decisions.
