### Year 2 Careers Day



On Monday, Year 2 students came to school dressed for the job they would like to do when they are older as part of our very own Careers Day. Children were transformed into authors, vets, a spy, an artist, doctors, an archaeologist and many more different roles, and undertook a range of 'work based' tasks requiring many of our learning skills to be used, in order to receive a stamp in their very own job files. The day was set up to embed our PSHE learning during this term, where children have explored different methods of payment, how people can earn money, how to keep money safe, and sensible choices when it comes to spending money, with a particular focus on 'wants and needs'. Tasks during the day included measuring and designing new homes in the architect's office, looking for and analysing clues as a detective in order to work out which suspect committed the crime, problem solving a patient's symptoms to work out their illness as well as measuring capacity in the classroom science lab. During the afternoon, we took a trip to the village shop and practised the life skill of communicating to others in a shop environment, purchasing items within a given budget and calculating change. To sum up the day, Alfie said, "It was so much fun!"
